
Launched in 2019, Building Bridges is a joint initiative, founded by Swiss public authorities (the Swiss Confederation, the Canton and City of Geneva), the finance community, the United Nations and NGOs to accelerate the transition to a global economic model aligned with sustainability goals. At the core of the initiative is the recognition that **the scale and complexity of the transition requires "building bridges" between multiple stakeholders** in the finance, government, and international development communities.

In 2024, after five years of commitment and growth, **Building Bridges transitions from an event to a foundation.** This evolution reflects our ongoing dedication to our mission and enables us to better respond to the needs of our partners and community. I strongly believe that **media is not just a channel for disseminating information but a transformative force that shapes narratives,** drives accountability, and mobilises action by raising important questions, elevating thought leadership and highlighting systemic solutions. 


The strength of Building Bridges lies in the **diversity** of its community: decision makers and actors from the finance and corporate sectors, government, civil society, academia and sustainable development.
